1. How do you see this garment/outfit as it compliments your body style?
 I have an athletic build and look for items that are a straighter or slightly slimmer fit. This jacket fit nicely off the rack; it was slim enough to fit my torso while being long enough in the arms. The slacks are also a straighter fit, making them a correct size around and still be long enough. I think the grey plaid jacket looks nice with my complexion and the tie gives a pop of color to the outfit. Overall, I feel like the pieces look well put together, are proportional on my body, and are a flattering fit.

2. Describe the need for the garment/outfit and how it fits into your current wardrobe.
 I often need both a complete suit as well as separate dress pieces for music concerts, church, judging contests, FFA, 4-H, and special events like weddings. I was able to put together a new look by purchasing only one new item. I will be able to wear this jacket with other slacks, as well as wearing each piece separately with other items in my closet, getting better use out of all items.
