Skill Description	Tools and Techniques Used
1. <u>Butt joint</u>	<u>connecting corners of flower box</u>
2. <u>Gluing</u>	<u>gluing seams before nailing</u>
3. <u>Nailing</u>	<u>nailing corners</u>
4. <u>Sanding</u>	<u>sanding to make smooth</u>
5. <u>Penetrating Finish</u>	<u>Stain and poly to help keep wood</u>

Other skills, tools, and techniques:

Wore eye protection during entire build. Used ear
protection while cutting wood and using sander. Used
a tape measure when measuring pieces of wood.
Used the band saw to cut the wood to size.
